

**ADVAN Sport, Size: 275/35ZR20 Part Number 10330, "B1" symbol on the sidewall.****How to Identify the New Tire**

Bentley Motor Limited has approved the new ADVAN Sport tire described above for replacement installations on Bentley Continental GT and Flying Spur vehicles. The tire has improved tread wear and noise performance characteristics. You can identify the new specification tire by the sidewall branding found following the size designation. The new tire will be branded "B1".

**B1 Tire Replacement**

Yokohama and Bentley highly recommends that all four tires are replaced as a set to achieve the desired vehicle performance characteristics. However, if only two new tires are purchased by the vehicle owner they should be applied to the rear axle. Inspect the used tires to be mounted on the front axle to ensure there are no tire conditions present that would preclude their continued usage. Consult the vehicle owner's manual for correct inflation pressure depending on operating conditions. Correct replacement is assured when you install Yokohama ADVAN Sport tires (part number 10330) in the size listed above which are available through Bentley dealers and Yokohama tire dealers.



## **Important Tire Replacement Considerations**

Yokohama ADVAN Sport tires specified above are designed to achieve specific performance levels defined by Bentley for the Continental GT and Flying Spur. Please be aware, when Bentley tires need to be replaced, it is important to install tires that have the same capabilities as the Yokohama ADVAN original equipment tires. Proper speed rating and load capacity are two capabilities that must be considered when choosing replacement tires. Continental GT and Flying Spur Bentley vehicles are capable of speeds up to 198 mph and have a curb weight range of 5258 to 5456 lbs. with more weight distributed to the front axle than the rear axle. The 20-inch original equipment tires are Z rated which means they have speed capacity above 186 mph. They also have an equivalent load index of 105 which means they each will carry loads of up to a maximum of 2039 lbs. when inflated to 42psi cold or higher pressure shown in the vehicle owner's manual up to the maximum of 50psi.

Please note: Winter tires specified by Bentley should be selected based on the Bentley owner's manual recommendations . *(Tires are available from Yokohama and other manufacturers in the same size designation but may carry lower load index and possibly speed ratings. These are not acceptable for replacement of the Bentley OE tire specified above.)*

## **Vehicle Service**

In order to assure maximum tread wear life, vehicle mechanical conditions, such as alignment, should be checked and corrected as required before new tires are placed into service.

## **Warranty Coverage**

Tire replacements for warrantable conditions submitted to Yokohama will be processed under the terms of the Yokohama Standard Limited Warranty for Original Equipment Tires. This includes free replacement and mounting and balancing during the first 2/32nds of tread wear or 12 months from the date of vehicle purchase, which ever is to the customer's benefit, when a warrantable condition is confirmed.
